- ▶ 3 credits Science

- ▶ 1 credit Fine Art
- ▶ Senior Year Math-Based Quantitative Course

# High School Programs

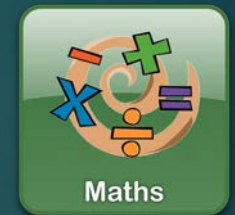
- ▶ Traditional program

- ▶ College Credit Opportunities
  - ▶ Advanced Placement (AP) programs
  - ▶ College in the High School (CHS)
  - ▶ Pacific NW College Credits

# Required 10<sup>th</sup> grade classes

- ▶ English 10 or Pre-AP English 10



- ▶ Math (Geometry or next level math)



- ▶ World History

(Unless you completed in 9<sup>th</sup> grade)

- ▶ Science- check prerequisites/math

# Online Registration Instructions



- ▶ Login to **StudentVue**; Have **Course Registration sheet** ready to guide you.
- ▶ Click on **Course Request**
- ▶ Enter each class you want **using the Course ID** (NOT THE CLASS NAME! MANY CLASSES HAVE SIMILAR TITLES).
- ▶ Be sure you select both semesters for year-long courses. ex: Biology SCB100 (**choose both A & B**).
- ▶ Don't forget your **alternates!!** Have back ups for:
  - First-year World Language
  - Any elective course (ex: 1<sup>st</sup> choice= Photography, alternate = Basic Art

No need to “save” or “lock course requests” – it auto-saves for you!
