If selected for NHS membership, students must complete 40 service hours per year. These hours must be designated to Honor Society exclusively (No Key Club hours or Boy Scout hours that are recognized elsewhere). *Please consider this time commitment when deciding whether to pursue membership.*

NHS DEFINITION OF COMMUNITY SERVICE

Community service activities are those which are done for, or on behalf of, others (not including immediate family members), for which no compensation (monetary or otherwise) has been given. Students who teach religion or assist at services are not considered to be providing community service to the public, and NHS does not allow the sanctioning of one particular religion by a public school club or activity. You may NOT submit hours that you have claimed for other purposes, such as Key Club hours. NHS strongly desires students to hold offices in organizations (such as President of ASB, etc.) and would like you to list any below.

* * * Honor Society Selection Procedure

After semester grades are posted, a faculty council selects students for membership from the pool of those who have a cumulative GPA of at least a 3.5. The other criteria used in the selection process are **service**, **character**, and **leadership**. To that end, students are encouraged to fill out a service Activities Information Form with reflections on character and current leadership, to assist the faculty council in their deliberations. Teachers may also be consulted regarding their students.

National Honor Society rules emphasize that students do not apply for membership in NHS, but are selected by the faculty council. Not everyone who meets the minimum requirements will be selected. A student not selected during sophomore year may, if the cumulative GPA requirement is maintained, resubmit an Activity Information Form in the spring of his or her junior year. Students who are selected must meet additional requirements for ongoing membership.
