### **NEW SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES:**

The Scholarship Foundation of Northshore (SFN) application window is open. This foundation offers scholarships for seniors attending all NSD High Schools.

Scholarships range from \$2000-\$7500 and some are renewable for four years. These scholarships will follow you to whatever school you plan to attend next year.

- The SFN has posted scholarships for the Class of 2020 and candidates are now able to apply online. All scholarship offerings are listed at <u>sf-ns.org</u>. Please view the scholarships and apply <u>by</u> <u>February 3, 2020!</u> Applicants only need to apply to one scholarship and their application will automatically be sent to other SFN scholarships if the student fits the criteria of a different scholarship.
- You may also be asked to submit an "unofficial transcript" along with the application. To request a transcript for this, PLEASE SIGN UP ON THE CLIPBOARD AT THE FRONT COUNTER OF THE COUNSELING OFFICE and include your email address! We will then email you a copy of your transcript to upload to your application. If you miss this step, your application will be deemed incomplete and won't be considered for the scholarship.
